We are overjoyed to celebrate the remarkable accomplishment of one of our youngest talents, **Nazakat U. Noorappanavar**, from Grade 2nd B.



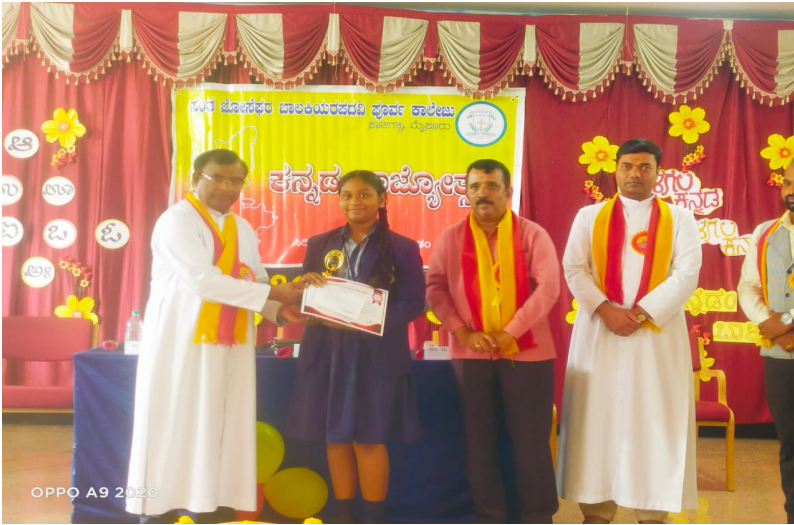
